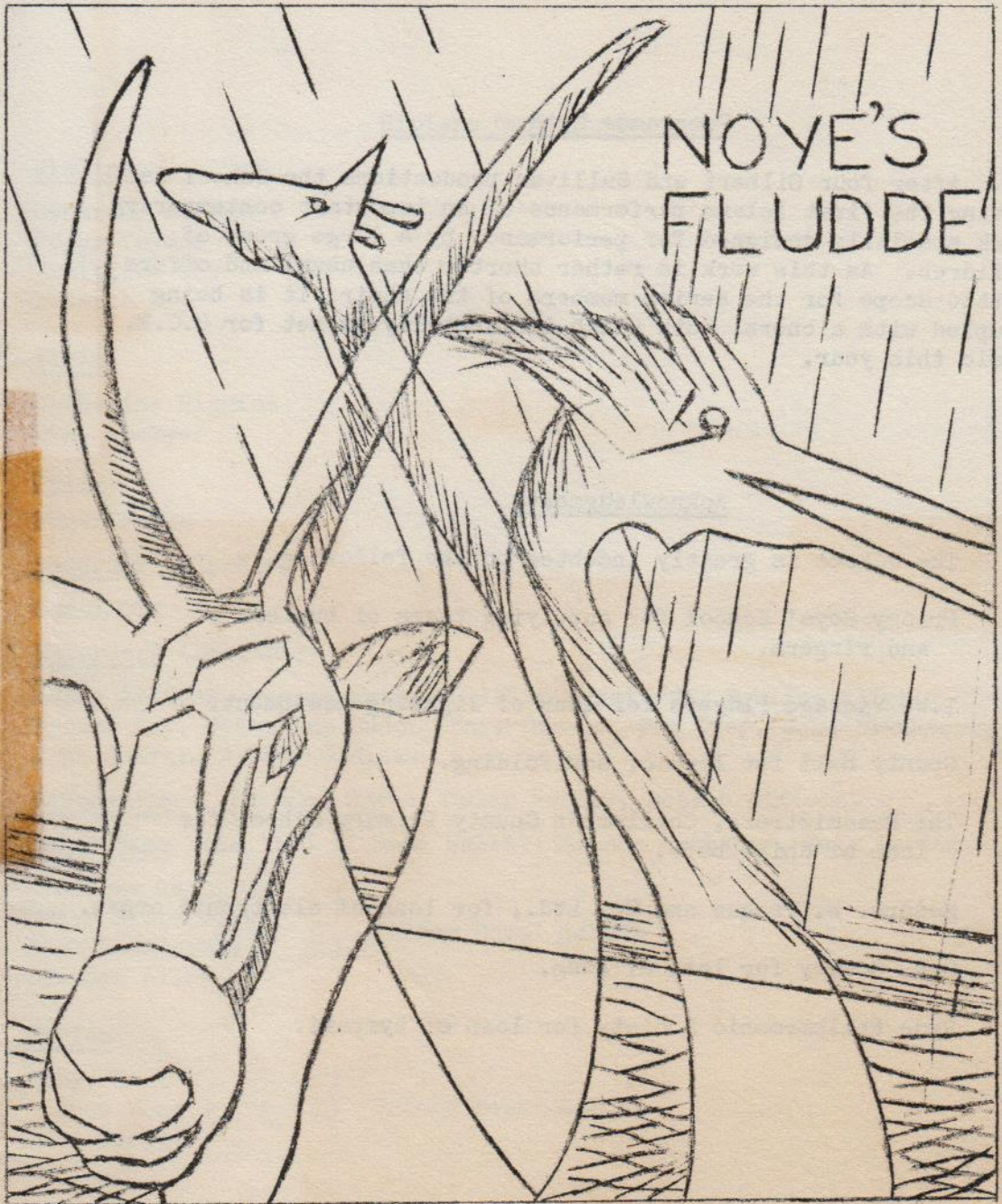


NOYE'S
